## Uniform Policy

The parents and staff at Our Lady's Assumption expect a high standard of dress to be maintained by all children.

Parents are asked to ensure the correct uniform is worn at all times. Wearing the correct uniform encourages a sense of pride in self and school.

Parents will be notified if the correct uniform is not worn.

The Uniform is as follows:

### Girls

#### Summer Term One and Four

- Maroon and gold check dress with embroidered school crest
- Short white socks with gold and maroon stripe
- Black leather school shoes (not joggers)
- Gold, maroon, black or white scrunchies/ribbons for shoulder length hair

#### Sport

- Gold polo top with school crest
- OLA maroon shorts
- School tracksuit, maroon/gold trim, embroidered school crest
- Sports shoes/joggers
- Short white ankle length socks with Dominican stripe

#### Winter Term Two and Three

- Maroon/grey tartan check pinafore (Year 1-4)
- Maroon/grey check skirt (Year 5-6)
- Lemon long sleeved blouse or short sleeved blouse
- School tie maroon/grey tartan
- Maroon school jumper with embroidered crest
- Grey tights (available through school uniform only) – MUST be worn on formal occasions
- Lemon socks with gold and maroon stripe
- Black leather school shoes
- Gold, maroon, black or white scrunchies/ribbons for shoulder length hair

#### The Uniform Shop opening times are:

**Tuesday 8.15am – 10.30am and Friday 1.30-3.30pm**

# Boys

## Summer Term One and Four

- Dark grey shorts
- Dark grey short sleeved shirt with crest on pocket
- Short grey socks with Dominican stripe
- Black leather school shoes (not joggers)

## Sport

- OLA maroon shorts
- Gold polo top with school crest
- School tracksuit, maroon/gold trim, embroidered school crest
- Sports shoes/joggers
- Short white ankle length socks with Dominican stripe

## Winter Term Two and Three

- Dark grey melange school trousers
- Dark grey long/short sleeved shirt with crest on pocket
- Maroon school jumper with embroidered crest
- School tie maroon/grey tartan
- Short grey socks with Dominican stripe
- Black leather school shoes (not joggers)

**Please give attention to ensure that children have:**

- 1) school sports socks.**
- 2) the correct regulation uniform with the school logo – correct colours – as supplied by the uniform shop.**
- 3) school hats, which must be worn out to play.**
- 4) names on their clothing.**

**There should be no mixing of the regulation uniform and sports uniform.**

**Grooming** **Hairstyles for both boys and girls** should be neat and tidy and reflect accepted standards. Shoulder length hair or longer is to be tied up. Parents are requested to refrain from allowing children to dye their hair during school terms. Scrunchies or ribbons need to be in school colours (maroon, gold, black or white). The Principal reserves the right to decide the acceptability of hairstyles. Parents are asked to ensure a high standard is maintained.

**Hats** All children must wear the school hat with embroidered crest. A 'no hat, no play' rule is enforced throughout the year. Children will be excluded from sport if their school hat is not worn. Children will be issued with a note to inform parents when they have been excluded from the lesson.

ALL school hats should be clearly labelled with your child's name and class. To reduce the incidents of head lice, each child needs to wear his/her own hat (no lending or borrowing).

**Jewellery** A watch and /or necklace with a Christian symbol may be worn. A signet ring may be worn. No nail polish, tattoos or makeup may be worn during school hours.  
**Girls and boys may wear one stud or sleeper (plain – eg gold or silver) in each ear lobe.**
