OLA Faction Sports Carnival

Dear Parents

The 2019 Sports Day will be held on Thursday 17 October 2019, at the Inglewood Athletics Club, located within the Dianella Regional Space. The relocation of our event from Noranda has been for the following reasons:

1. It has a secure fence/gates surrounding the track and will ensure the safety of all students;
2. It is more cost effective as it is located in the City of Stirling rather than the City of Bayswater;
3. It is being resurfaced prior to the marking of the track (better surface for our students).

The following is the information regarding Champion and Runner Up Age winners for the OLA Faction Sports Carnival:

- Students will participate in trials at Noranda Sporting Complex on Monday 23 September 2019;
- Students will be placed into divisions for the Sports Day according to their times i.e. fastest 1-8 = A Division, 9-16 = B Division, 17-24 = C Division, 24-32 = D Division;
- Students will be competing in field events (shot put, turbo javelin and discus) during lesson time, at school. Long jump will take place on the same day as the trials at Noranda.

Individual points for Age Champions are based on:

1. Places for all four field events, long jump, discus, shot put and turbo javelin. These measurements are taken during lesson time in Week 8, 9 and 10 of Term 3;
2. All A Division track events 75m/100m, 200m, 400m and the 800m for Year 5 and 6 students.

The points allocation is as follows:

- 1st place awarded 30 points
- 2nd place awarded 26 points
- 3rd place awarded 22 points
- 4th place awarded 18 points
- 5th place awarded 14 points
- 6th place awarded 10 points
- 7th place awarded 2 points
- 8th place awarded 1 point

- **NB** - Please note that only A Division events will receive points for individual Age Champions. Champion Girl/Boy and Runner Up Trophies for each age group (Years 3-6) will be presented at the conclusion of the Carnival. All other division events (B-D) will not go towards Age Championship Points.
- Students will be selected for the CPSSA event (OLA Interschool Team) in Term 4 based on the below results:
 - First and second place for field events of long jump, turbo javelin and shot put;
 - First to fourth for sprint events (75m/100m, 200m);
 - First and second place for the 400m per year group per gender;
 - Only two competitors in the open 800m based on times from the trials or carnival.



As mentioned previously, the students who achieve the best times, during the trials and/or the carnival events, will be selected to represent the school.

- Exemption:
 - If students are absent while their class groups are having measurements for field events taken, it is their responsibility to have these recorded at a time that is convenient for both the student and Sports Teacher before the Sports Carnival.
 - If students are absent for the Athletic Trials, they will be placed in the division they raced in the previous year's Carnival. If they are absent for the Carnival but record faster times in the trials than those recorded in the Carnival, they will be selected for Interschool events. Every effort will be made to ensure that all children have fair and equal opportunities to be measured in the field and on the track.
 - There will be a novelty hurdles race for all age groups which will not contribute to individual Championship Points.

The below information is provided to help with organisation on the day:

- **Drop Off** – Students will have the option of being dropped off at the Athletics Track from 8.30am or departing on the bus from OLA at 8.40am. Please advise on the permission slip if your child will require a seat on the bus to and from the carnival;
- **Faction Shirts** – Students are requested to wear a plain faction coloured t-shirt on the day;
- **Hairspray / Zinc** – Students are permitted coloured hair spray, ribbons and/or zinc, but must be applied at **home**. Students are not permitted to bring these items (hair spray and zinc) to the Carnival;
- **Coffee Van** – There will be a coffee van on site for our Carnival. A portion of the funds received from purchasing coffee, will be returned to the OLA P&F.
- **Boundaries** – In the best interest and safety of all our students, parents are requested to remain behind the fence that surrounds the running track. Please support the staff and adhere to this rule so that we can ensure the children are safe and available to participate in their events when called. Students will be permitted to spend time with their parents during the lunch break.
- **Pre-Primary** – Pre-Primary students will be departing OLA on the bus at 9.45. They will participate in a track event and then four short team games. They will then depart the Carnival at 11.30 to return to OLA. Pre-Primary students are permitted to remain at the Carnival to support their older siblings once signed out by their parent (please liaise with your child's classroom teacher);
- **Program** – An electronic copy of the program will be attached with this letter. An individualised hard copy will be sent home on Thursday 26 September with your child's races and team games highlighted.
- **Results** – Timing Gates WA have been employed to time all track events. All results will be final.

Attached to this letter is a copy of the program for the day and a map of the venue. These will also be uploaded to this week's newsletter. The full program, with names, will be placed on the window of the Library on Thursday 26 September 2019.

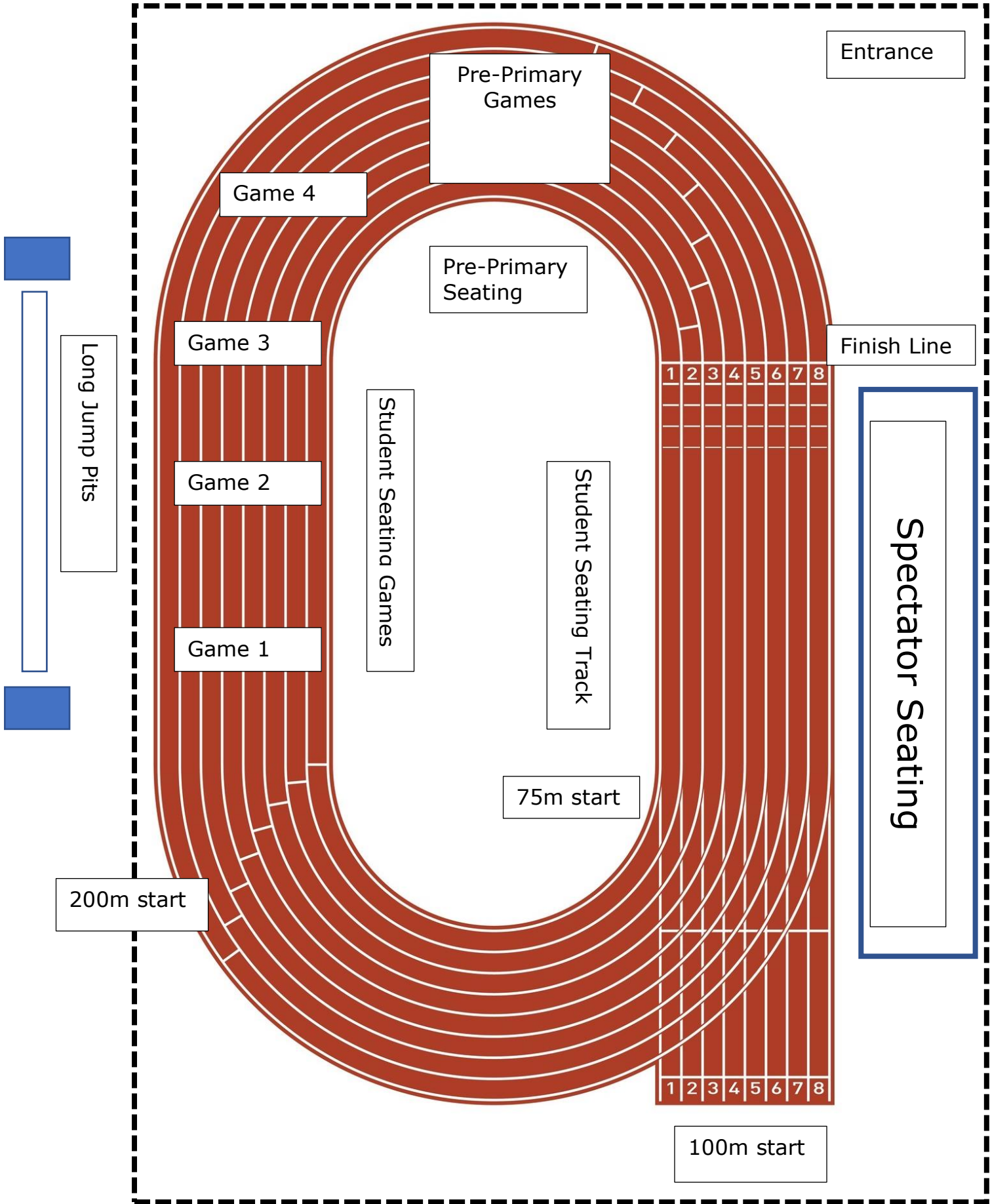
