The theme of the concert is, *Music Through the Decades*. All families are invited to attend this special event.

Costumes for the concert are outlined below:

Class	Costume Details
Kindy G and Kindy M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- colourful free dress (dance appropriate)</li><li>- Shorts/leggings must be worn under any skirts</li><li>- colourful accessories</li></ul>
Pre-Primary G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- party style fancy dress</li><li>- shorts/leggings must be worn under any skirts</li><li>- shirts and trousers/jeans for boys if possible</li><li>- bow ties/bows in hair</li></ul>
Pre-Primary M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- bathers and swim wear that is appropriate for dancing in (pants or leggings over bathers)</li><li>- beach clothes, summer clothes</li><li>- shorts or leggings underneath any skirts</li><li>- goggles around neck</li></ul>
Year 1G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- black and white "jailhouse" stripes</li><li>- shorts/leggings must be worn under any skirts</li><li>- anything black and white</li></ul>
Year 1M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- orange or red coloured tops - to give a "baby bird" look</li><li>- black shorts, pants or leggings</li></ul>
Year 2G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- rainbow coloured tops and accessories (think 1990s)</li><li>- black or dark denim pants, leggings or track pants</li></ul>
Year 2M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- black tops and pants with gold accessories (e.g. gold chains, beanies, wrist ties)</li><li>- loose-fitting black "harem pants" or track pants</li><li>- hip-hop style loose clothes</li></ul>
Year 3G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- white t-shirts</li><li>- light denim pants/overalls etc. if possible or any light-coloured pants</li><li>- leggings must be worn under any skirts</li><li>- red and light denim accessories</li></ul>
Year 3M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- white t-shirts</li><li>- dark denim pants if possible or black track pants</li><li>- blue accessories</li></ul>
Year 4G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- white t-shirts</li><li>- black dark denim pants or trackpants/leggings if possible</li><li>- boys slick hair</li><li>- black and white accessories (e.g. glasses, caps, hair ties, arm bands etc)</li></ul>





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Year 4M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- black or dark coloured t-shirts</li><li>- light denim pants if possible or light pants of any sort</li><li>- blue and silver accessories (e.g. caps, hair ties, arm bands etc)</li></ul>
Year 5G and Year 5M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- 70s disco attire</li><li>- flare pants or colourful dresses (shorts or leggings underneath) with colourful accessories for girls</li><li>- white dress shirt with collar and black trousers for boys if possible, otherwise black denim</li><li>- gold chains and other 70s accessories</li></ul>
Year 6G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- fluoro coloured tops</li><li>- denim jeans for boys</li><li>- colourful skirts/leggings for girls</li><li>- colourful accessories (e.g. legwarmers, headbands, arm ties etc)</li></ul>
Year 6M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- fluoro coloured tops</li><li>- denim jeans for boys</li><li>- colourful skirts/leggings for girls</li><li>- colourful accessories (e.g. legwarmers, headbands, arm ties etc)</li></ul>

Please collect the above items, label them and keep them ready for show day. Students will get changed at school throughout the day, in preparation for the dress rehearsal and concert on Wednesday 25 September. Please note, you are not required to buy any new items.
