- 1. All authority forms must be returned to the Centre at least ONE WEEK prior to Vacation Care commencing. This is so we know how many children are attending and can staff accordingly.**
2. Staff must be informed in writing if a person other than the parent/guardian is picking up your child/ren.
3. The Centre operating hours are 7am to 6pm each day. We cannot accept children before or after these times due to our licensing conditions.
4. Children attending the excursions (if any) are required to return a excursion consent form prior to the excursion.
- 5. All fees must be paid via Direct Debit and families must have a current Direct Debit form on file before attending. All fees must be paid no later than one week after the completion of the Vacation Care Programme.**
