Sun Safety Policy Extract

All children must bring a sun smart hat on the days they are attending. If children require specific brands/sensitivity sunscreen this must also be provided by the family each day attended.

Transport/Excursions Policy Extract

OLA OSHC is committed to providing safe transport for enrolled children who participate in excursions organized by the service. All educators involved in transport of children will be aware of correct transport procedures and will comply with road traffic laws at all times. Children will be carefully supervised while being transported in a vehicle or by foot and during excursions.

Fees Policy Extract

\$78 per child per day (not included in this fee is any excursion fee to cover the cost of excursion venue entry fees and transport cost.) Places are limited to 45 spots, as Vacation Care is considered a casual booking 24 hours' notice must be given for changes to or cancellation of your booking. We operate on a first come first served basis.

If your child has not attended OLA OSHC before, you will need to complete an OLA enrolment form and direct debit form in addition to the vacation care form.

- 1. All authority forms must be returned to the Centre at least ONE WEEK prior to Vacation Care commencing. This is so we know how many children are attending and can staff accordingly.
- 2. Staff must be informed in writing if a person other than the parent/guardian is picking up your child/ren.
- 3. The Centre operating hours are 7am to 6pm each day. We cannot accept children before or after these times due to our licensing conditions.
- 4. Children attending the excursions (if any) are required to return a excursion consent form prior to the excursion.
- 5. All fees must be paid via Direct Debit and families must have a current Direct Debit form on file before attending. All fees must be paid no later than one week after the completion of the Vacation Care Program.
- 6. It is the parent's responsibility to provide their Child Care Subsidy details to the Centre. Please note that without Customer Reference Numbers we cannot pass on CCS. Families will need to confirm their enrolment on their myGov account.
- 7. Failure to show up to booked care will result in full fees being charged.
- 8. Once enrolments have been confirmed if you need to make any cancellations, you must do so one-week prior in writing to the OSHC Supervisor. Cancellations that do not meet this timeframe cannot be accepted and parents will be required to pay for these days.
