# Vision Statement

### RATIONALE

The parents and staff at Our Lady's Assumption expect a high standard of dress to be maintained by all children.

Parents are asked to ensure the correct uniform is worn at all times. Wearing the correct uniform encourages a sense of pride in self and school.

Parents will be notified if the correct uniform is not worn.

# All Pre-Primary Students

#### All Terms

- Maroon and black unisex polo top with school crest
- Black shorts with school crest
- o School tracksuit with embroidered school crest
- Sports shoes/joggers
- Short white ankle length socks

# <u>Years 1 – 6 Girls</u>

### Summer (Term One and Term Four)

- $\circ$  White unisex shirt with embroidered school crest to be worn in or out depending on length of top
- Charcoal skirt or shorts
- White academic socks with school stripe
- Black leather school shoes (not joggers) or sandals
- Maroon, black, grey or white scrunchies/ribbons for shoulder length hair

#### Sport

- Maroon and black unisex polo top with school crest
- Black shorts with school crest
- School tracksuit with embroidered school crest
- Sports shoes/joggers
- Short white ankle length socks

# Winter (Term Two and Term Three)

- $\circ$   $\,$  White unisex shirt with embroidered school crest to be worn in or out depending on length of top
- $\circ$   $\,$  Charcoal skirt, shorts or pants
- Black leather school shoes (not joggers)
- School tie maroon/grey
- Maroon school jumper
- o Black tights or white academic socks with school stripe
- Black leather school shoes
- Maroon, black, grey or white scrunchies/ribbons for shoulder length hair

# <u>Years 1 – 6 Boys</u>

### Summer (Term One and Term Four)

- $\circ~$  White unisex shirt with embroidered school crest to be worn in or out depending on length of top
- o Charcoal shorts
- Grey academic socks with school stripe
- o Black leather school shoes (not joggers) or sandals

### Sport

- Maroon and black unisex polo top with school crest
- Black shorts with school crest
- o School tracksuit with embroidered school crest
- Sports shoes/joggers
- Short white ankle length socks

### Winter (Term Two and Term Three)

- $\circ$   $\,$  White unisex shirt with embroidered school crest to be worn in or out depending on length of top
- o Charcoal shorts or pants
- Black leather school shoes (not joggers)
- School tie maroon/grey
- Maroon school jumper
- o Grey academic socks with school stripe

All uniform items are supplied by Nell Gray and are available for purchase at their Inglewood Superstore or online via their website. Please refer to the OLA Uniform Guide for images and current pricing.

Please give attention to ensure that children have:

- the correct regulation uniform with the school logo correct colours as supplied by Nell Gray;
- 2) school hats, which must be worn out to play;
- 3) names on their clothing.

There should be no mixing of the regular uniform and sports uniform.

All students are required to be in the new uniform items by the commencement of the 2024 academic year.

- **Grooming** Hairstyles for both boys and girls should be neat and tidy and reflect accepted standards. Shoulder length hair or longer is to be tied up. Parents are requested to refrain from allowing children to dye their hair during school terms. Scrunchies or ribbons need to be in school colours (maroon, black, grey or white). The Principal reserves the right to decide the acceptability of hairstyles. Parents are asked to ensure a high standard is maintained.
- **Hats** All children must wear the school hat with embroidered crest. A 'no hat, no play' rule is enforced throughout the year. Children will be excluded from sport if their school hat is not worn. Children will be issued with a note to inform parents when they have been excluded from the lesson.

All school hats should be clearly labelled with your child's name and class. To reduce the incidents of head lice, each child needs to wear his/her own hat (no lending or borrowing).

**Jewellery** A watch and /or necklace with a Christian symbol may be worn. A signet ring may be worn. No nail polish, tattoos or makeup may be worn during school hours.

Girls and boys may wear one stud or sleeper (plain – e.g. gold or silver) in each ear lobe.
